









What is a standard?

ISO STANDARDS ARE INTERNATIONALLY AGREED BY EXPERTS


Think of them as a formula that describes the best way of doing something.

It could be about making a product, managing a process, delivering a service or supplying materials – standards cover a huge range of activities.

Standards are the distilled wisdom of people with expertise in their subject matter and who know the needs of the organizations they represent – people such as manufacturers, sellers, buyers, customers, trade associations, users or regulators.




Technical standard

A technical standard is an established norm or requirement for a repeatable technical task.

It is usually a formal document that establishes uniform engineering or technical criteria, methods, processes, and practices.

What is a (technical) standard?

A standard is a document that gives

- requirements,
- specifications,
- guidelines or
- characteristics

That can be used in a **consistent** manner to ensure that materials, products and services are **fit for purpose**.

What is a (technical) standard? (cont'd)

- Can give specifications for the performance of products or staff
- Can define terms to avoid semantic discussions as much as possible

Management Systems Standard

A management system standard (MSS) help organizations improve their performance by:

- specifying repeatable steps that organizations consciously implement to achieve their goals and objectives,
- creating an organizational culture that reflexively engages in a continuous cycle of self-evaluation, correction and improvement of operations and processes through heightened employee awareness and management leadership and commitment.







Evolution of FM standards


