CYS

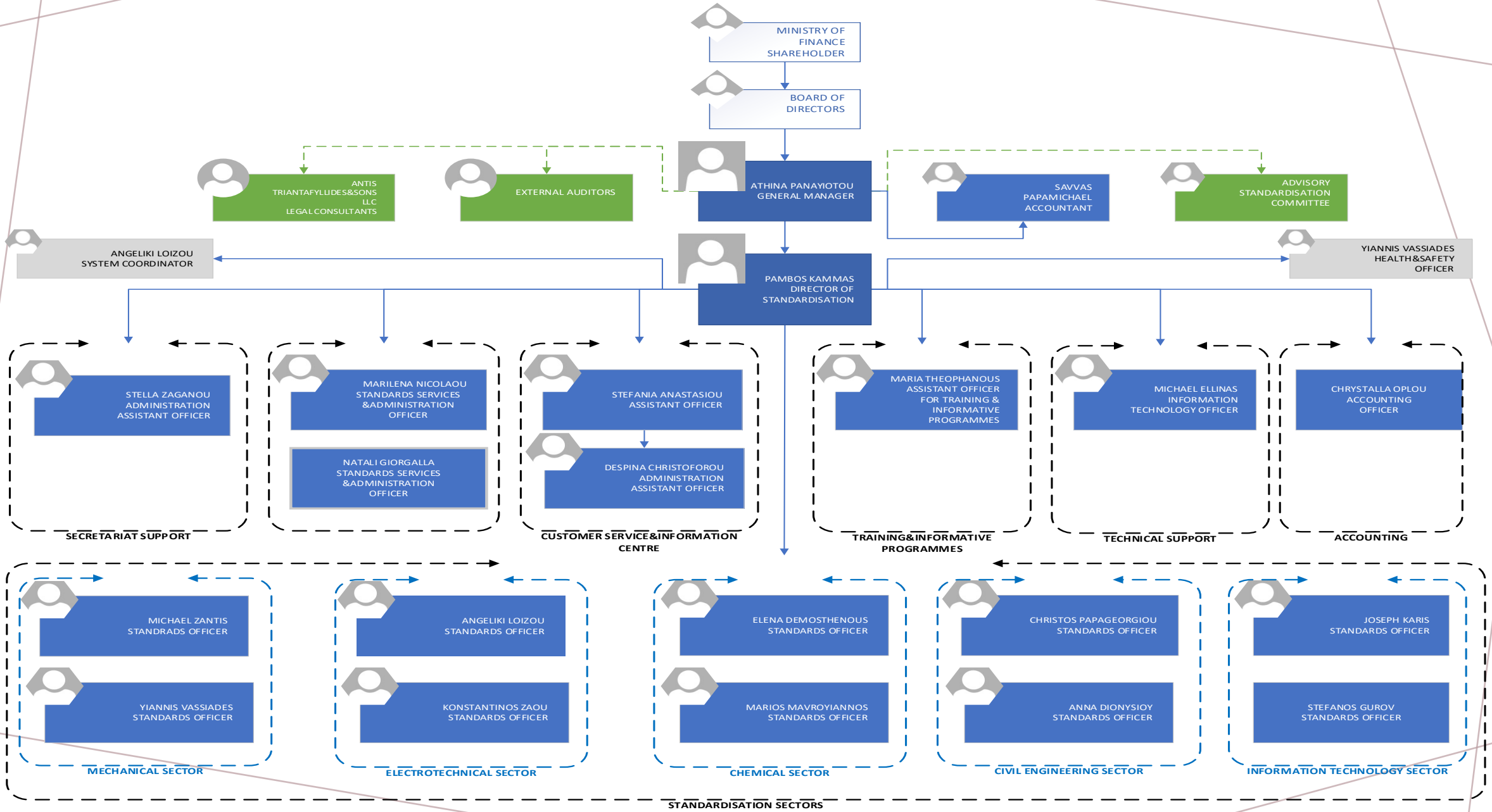
- Independent, autonomous organisation from the 1st of January 2005
- Operates under Private Law
- Recognized as the National Standards Body of Cyprus
- The Ministry of Finance is the only shareholder



AUTONOMY OF CYS

- **2005 – STATUS change – Metamorphosis**
- **1975-2005**
 - Public Body under full governmental control
- **2005-Today**
 - Independent autonomous body under private law
 - More flexible
 - Better response
 - Less expensive to operate

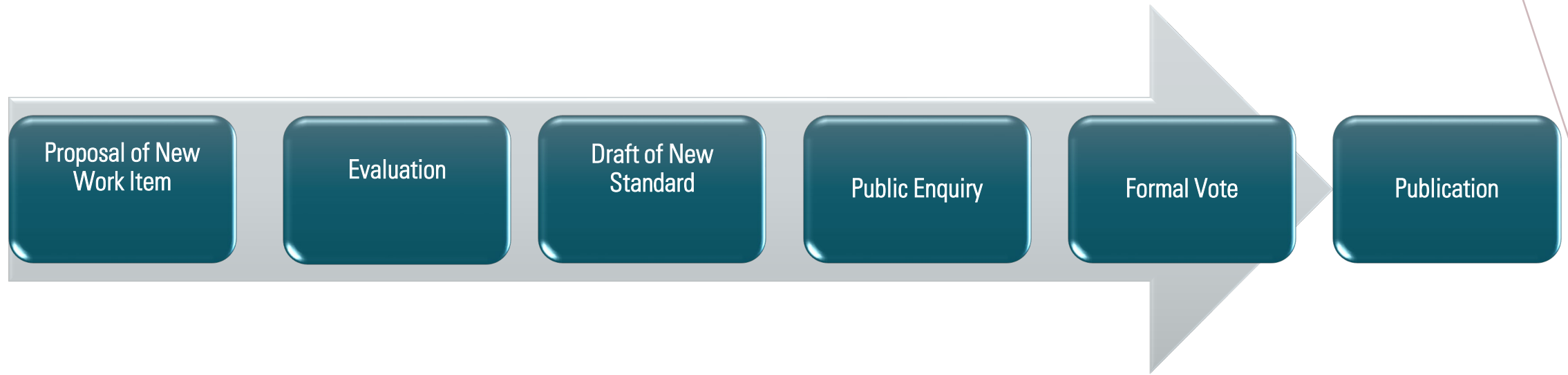

STANDARD

- means a **technical specification**, adopted by a recognized standardisation body, for repeated or continuous application with which compliance is not compulsory and which is one of the following:
 - “**international standard**” means a standard adopted by an international standardisation body
 - “**European standard**” means a standard adopted by a European standardisation organisation
 - “**harmonised standard**” means a European standard adopted on the basis of a request made by the Commission for the application of Union harmonisation legislation
 - “**national standard**” means a standard adopted by a national standardisation body

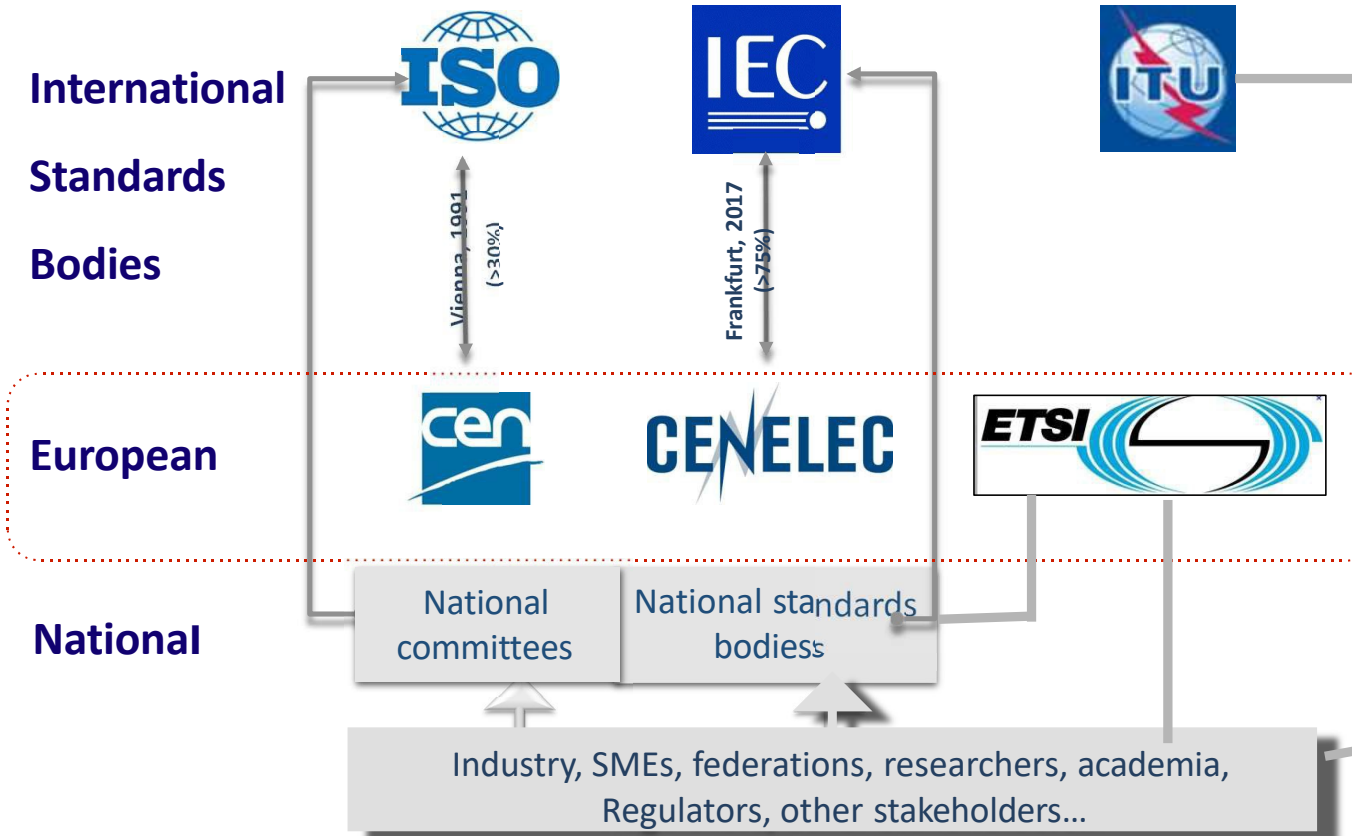
