## CYS


Independent, autonomous organisation from the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2005

- Operates under Private Law
- Recognized as the National Standards Body of Cyprus
- The Ministry of Finance is the only shareholder

- Public Body under full governmental control



SECTION 2: HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN STANDARDISATION ACTIVITIES



# STANDARD

- means a technical specification, adopted by a recognized standardisation body, for repeated or continuous application with which compliance is not compulsory and which is one of the following:
  - "international standard" means a standard adopted by an international standardisation body
  - "european standard" means a standard adopted by a European standardisation organisation
  - "harmonised standard" means a European standard adopted on the basis of a request made by the Commission for the application of Union harmonisation legislation
  - "national standard" means a standard adopted by a national standardisation body

 Development of national standards, specifications etc



- The first 2 standards: EN 15221-1 Facility Management Terns and Definitions, including the FM Model

EN 15221-2 Facility Management Agreements

EN 15221-3 Quality in Facility Management EN 15221-4 Facility Management Taxonomy EN 15221-5 Processes in Facility Management EN 15221-6 Space Measurement in Facility Management EN 15221-7 Benchmarking in Facility Management 2006-2012 FM standards EN 15221 called "the Magnificent Seven"
